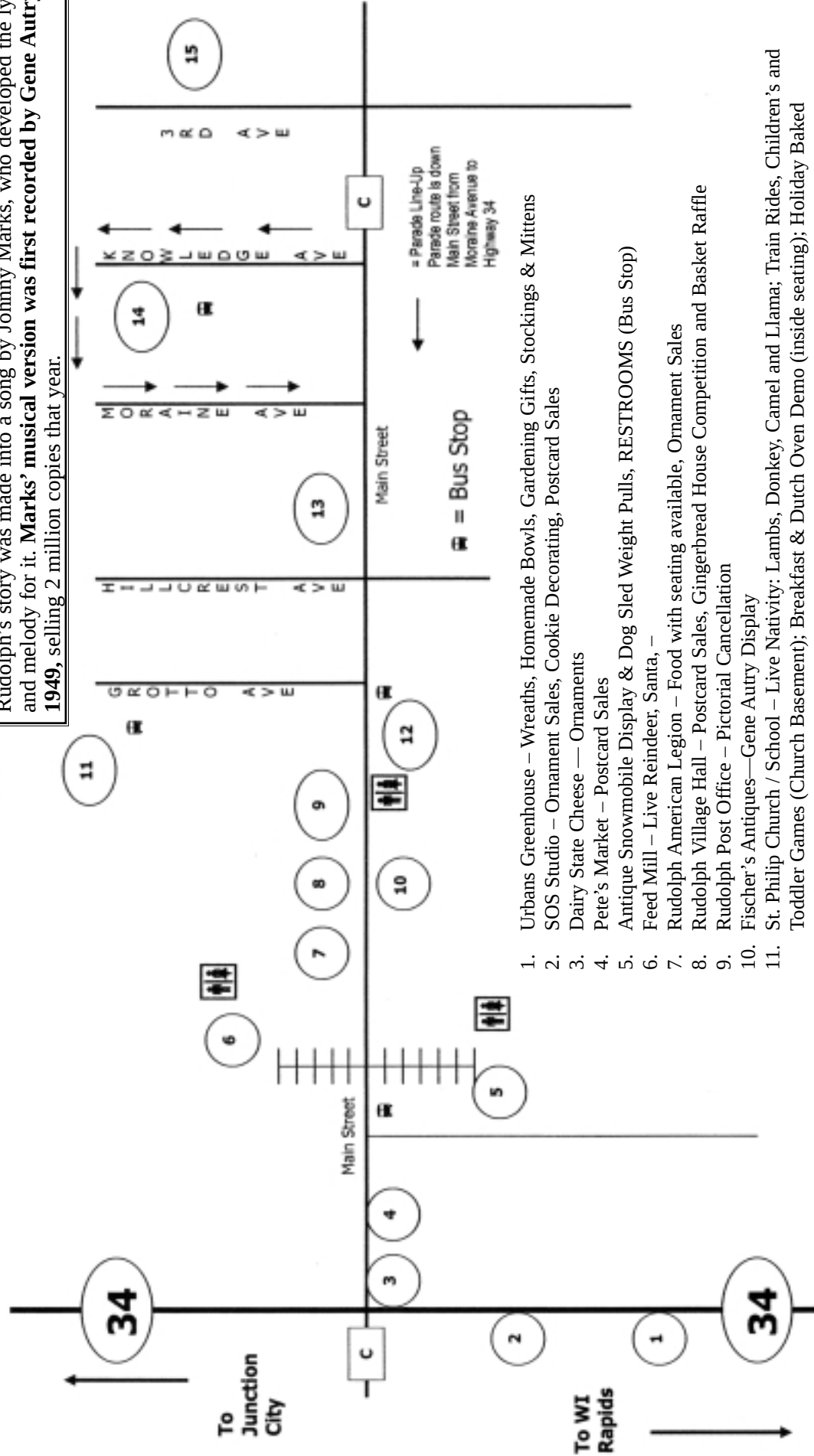

Celebrating 60 Years of Rudolph The Red-Nosed Reindeer by Gene Autry
 The story of *Rudolph The Red-Nosed Reindeer* was written in 1939 by Robert L. May, for the Chicago-based Montgomery Ward stores, as a customer promotional. Rudolph's story was made into a song by Johnny Marks, who developed the lyrics and melody for it. **Marks' musical version was first recorded by Gene Autry in 1949**, selling 2 million copies that year.
